## Important Note for Orthographic conversions

All the three views of orthographic conversions have to be shown in first angle projection only.

This means that the rule to be followed is top view should be below the front view and the side view should be on the left or right of the front view depending on whether it is left side view or right side view.

In the problems and solutions of Orthographic conversions, sometimes the top view is shown above and the other two views, namely the front view and side view are shown below the top view.

But it has to be read as third angle projection.
In exam, unless mentioned, the views have to be drawn only in first angle projection.
Hence check the solutions and correlate them with respect to first angle projection.
